1.5	Section 1. LOW-VALUE HEALTH SERVICES STUDY.
1.6	(a) The commissioner of health shall examine and analyze:
1.7	(1) the alignment in health care delivery with specific best practices guidelines or
1.8	recommendations; and
1.9	(2) health care services and procedures for purposes of identifying, measuring, and
1.10	potentially eliminating those services or procedures with low value and little benefit to
