1.9	Subdivision 1. Requirements for a provisional license. An applicant may be issued a
1.10	provisional license if the applicant:
1.11	(1) was born in a foreign country;

1.13	(3) has taken the applicable examination administered by the Association of Social Work
1.14	Boards or similar examination body designated by the board;

148D.061 PROVISIONAL LICENSES.

Subd. 9. **Revocation of provisional license.** The board may immediately revoke the provisional license of a licensee who violates any requirements of this section. The revocation must be made for cause. A licensee whose provisional license is revoked must immediately return the provisional license to the board.
