1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 152.137, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7Subd. 2. **Prohibited conduct.** (a) No person may knowingly engage in any of the

1.8following activities in the presence of a child or vulnerable adult; in the residence of a child

1.9or a vulnerable adult; in a building, structure, conveyance, or outdoor location where a child

1.10or vulnerable adult might reasonably be expected to be present; in a room offered to the

1.11public for overnight accommodation; or in any multiple unit residential building:

1.12(1) manufacturing or attempting to manufacture methamphetamine;

1.13(2) storing any chemical substance;

1.14(3) storing any methamphetamine waste products; or

1.15(4) storing any methamphetamine paraphernalia.

1.16(b) No person may knowingly cause or permit a child or vulnerable adult to inhale, be

1.17exposed to, have contact with, or ingest methamphetamine, a chemical substance, or

1.18methamphetamine paraphernalia.

1.19(c) No person may knowingly cause or permit a child or vulnerable adult to inhale, be

1.20exposed to, have contact with, or ingest fentanyl.
