1.7	Section 1. Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 8, article 1, section 20, subdivision
1.8	21, as amended by Laws 2018, chapter 214, article 2, section 40, is amended to read:
1.9 1.10	Subd. 21. St. Paul - Minnesota Museum of American Art6,000,000
1.11	For a grant to the St. Paul Port Authority to
1.12	acquire, design, construct, furnish, and equip
1.13	new museum galleries and an art study facility
1.14	for the Minnesota Museum of American Art.
1.15	This facility provides space to celebrate the
1.16	legacy of Minnesota art and artists and is part

3.25	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the St. Paul
3.26	Port Authority to acquire, design, construct, furnish, and equip the Minnesota Museum of
3.27	American Art in the historic Pioneer Endicott Building. This appropriation is in addition to
3.28	the amount appropriated by Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 8, article 1, section
