- Subd. 8. Program approval. To be eligible for revenue for the program for adults with 17 disabilities, a program and budget must receive approval from the (a) Beginning July 1, 1.8 2024, and at least once every five years thereafter, a district's community education section 1.9 in the department advisory council must review and approve the district's adults with 1.10 disabilities program. Approval may be for five years. During that time, a board must report 1.11 any significant changes to the department for approval. For programs offered cooperatively, 1.12 the request for approval must include an agreement on the method by which local money 1.13 is to be derived and distributed.
