BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1 5 Section 1. DAKOTA-SCOTT COUNTIES; HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE 1.6 AND RECYCLING FACILITY. 1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$8,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.8 to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant under the solid waste capital assistance grant 1.9 program in Minnesota Statutes, section 115A.54, to the joint powers entity established under 1.10 Minnesota Statutes, section 471.59, subdivision 1, between Dakota and Scott Counties, to 1.11 design, construct, and equip a new regional facility to process household hazardous waste 1.12 and recycling for Dakota and Scott Counties. The facility will be located in Dakota County 1.13 at a site that best supports access needs for residents and businesses from both Dakota and 1.14 Scott Counties. 1.15 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.16 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.17 the state in an amount up to \$8,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.18 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.19 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.21
