1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 85.32, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6Subdivision 1. **Areas marked.** The commissioner of natural resources is authorized

1.7in cooperation with local units of government and private individuals and groups when

1.8feasible to mark state water trails on the Little Fork, Big Fork, Minnesota, St. Croix,

1.9Snake, Mississippi, Red Lake, Cannon, Straight, Des Moines, Crow Wing, St. Louis, Pine,

1.10Rum, Kettle, Cloquet, Root, Zumbro, Pomme de Terre within Swift County, Watonwan,

1.11Cottonwood, Whitewater, Chippewa from Benson in Swift County to Montevideo in

1.12Chippewa County, Long Prairie, Red River of the North, Sauk, Otter Tail, Redwood,

1.13Blue Earth, Cedar, and Crow Rivers which have historic and scenic values and to mark

1.14appropriately points of interest, portages, camp sites, and all dams, rapids, waterfalls,

1.15whirlpools, and other serious hazards which are dangerous to canoe, kayak, and watercraft

1.16travelers.
