1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for construction of a new

1.3National Loon Center in the city of Crosslake; authorizing the sale and issuance

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. CROSSLAKE; NATIONAL LOON CENTER.

1.7Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.8to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Crosslake for site

1.9preparation and to construct, furnish, and equip a new building and adjacent outdoor public

1.10space improvements, including surface lot parking areas, in the city of Crosslake to house

1.11the National Loon Center, to provide visitor, education, and exhibit facilities for the general

1.12public.

1.13Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.14proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.15the state in an amount up to \$6,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.16prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.17Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
