1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for closed landfill cleanup;

1.3authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **CLOSED LANDFILL CLEANUP.**

1.6Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$11,350,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.7fund to the Pollution Control Agency to design and construct remedial systems and acquire

1.8land at closed landfills throughout the state in accordance with the closed landfill program

1.9under Minnesota Statutes, sections 115B.39 to 115B.42. The agency must follow the agency

1.10priorities, which include a construction project at the waste disposal engineering (WDE)

1.11site in Anoka County.

1.12Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.13proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.14the state in an amount up to \$11,350,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.15prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.16Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
