A "prior qualified human 1.8 trafficking-related offense" means a previous conviction or delinquency adjudication within 1.9 the ten years from the discharge from probation or parole immediately preceding the current 1.10 offense for a violation of or an attempt to violate section 609.322, subdivision 1 (solicitation, 1.11 inducement, and promotion of prostitution; sex trafficking in the first degree); 609.322, 1.12 subdivision 1a (solicitation, inducement, and promotion of prostitution; sex trafficking in 1.13 the second degree); 609.282 (labor trafficking); or 609.283 (unlawful conduct with respect 1.14 to documents in furtherance of labor or sex trafficking); or a statute from another state or 1.15 the United States in conformity with any of these offenses. 1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2024, and applies to crimes 1.17 committed on or after that date. 1.18
