1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[124D.792] GRADUATION CEREMONIES; TRIBAL REGALIA AND**

1.7 **OBJECTS OF CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE.**

1.8 A school district or charter school must not prohibit an American Indian student from

1.9 wearing American Indian regalia, Tribal regalia, or objects of cultural significance at a

1.10 graduation ceremony.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
