1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 177.42, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 4. <b>Prevailing hours of labor.</b> (a) "Prevailing hours of labor" means the hours
1.7	of labor per day and per week worked within the area by a larger number of workers of the
1.8	same class than are employed within the area for any other number of hours per day and
1.9	per week. The prevailing hours of labor may not be more than eight hours per day or more
1.10	than 40 hours per week, except as provided in paragraph (b).
1.11	(b) For highway and heavy construction projects, as defined by Minnesota Rules,
1.12	part 5200.1010, the prevailing hours of labor may not be more than ten hours per day
1.13	or more than 40 hours per week.
