ST. LOUIS COUNTY; LEACHATE SYSTEM REPLACEMENT. 1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.7 to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to St. Louis County to predesign, design, engineer, 1.8 and construct the replacement of the leachate treatment system at the St. Louis County 1.9 Regional Landfill. This appropriation includes money for a control building, aeration and 1.10 treatment ponds, an ultra filtration system, and an engineered manufactured wetland to 1.11 reduce perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances. 1.12 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.14 the state in an amount up to \$4,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.17
