1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; appropriating money for tourism-related losses.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; TOURISM-RELATED LOSSES.**

1.5 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the general fund to the Minnesota
1.6 Department of Employment and Economic Development to distribute to a federally
1.7 recognized Indian Tribe in Minnesota located within ten miles of the Canadian border. This
1.8 appropriation shall be used for tourism-related losses due to the closure of the International
1.9 Canadian border as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
