1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing an intoxicating liquor license for a golf course in
1.3 Becker.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **SPECIAL LICENSE; BECKER.**

1.6 Notwithstanding any law or ordinance to the contrary, the city of Becker may issue
1.7 an on-sale intoxicating liquor license for a golf course that is located at 14000 Clubhouse
1.8 Lane and is owned by the city. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not
1.9 inconsistent with this section, apply to the license issued under this section. The city
1.10 of Becker is deemed the licensee under this section, and the provisions of Minnesota
1.11 Statutes, sections 340A.603 and 340A.604, apply to the license as if the establishment
1.12 were a municipal liquor store.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the Becker City
1.14 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
