1.7	the federal coronavirus relief fund to the commissioner of agriculture to contract with food
1.8	hubs, meal organizations, and distributors and to purchase product directly from Minnesota
1.9	producers who sell in local and regional markets and were negatively impacted by
1.10	COVID-19.
1.11	Subd. 2. Eligible expenditures; availability. (a) Money appropriated in subdivision 1
1.12	may not be spent until the commissioner of management and budget determines that the
