BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; VOYAGEUR COUNTRY ATV TRAIL.

\$600,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources. Of this amount, \$100,000 is for a grant to St. Louis County for an environmental assessment worksheet for the overall construction of the Voyageur Country ATV Trail system and connections and \$500,000 is for a grant to St. Louis County to design, plan, permit, acquire right-of-way for, and construct Voyageur Country ATV Trail from Buyck to the Holmes Logging Road and to the Shuster Road toward Cook.

Sec. 2. PROSPECTOR LOOP TRAIL; TACONITE STATE TRAIL.

\$2,400,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the

natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources. Of this amount, \$1,300,000

is for a grant to Lake County to match other funding sources to develop the Prospector Loop

Trail system and \$1,100,000 is for a grant to Lake County for design, environmental review,

permitting, and construction for all-terrain vehicle use on the Taconite State Trail between

Ely and Tower.
