1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to motor vehicles; establishing a special plate for recipients of the
1.3 Distinguished Flying Cross medal; making technical and clarifying changes;
1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections 168.123; 168.1291, subdivision 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 168.123, is amended to read:

1.7 168.123 VETERANS; SPECIAL PLATES.

1.8 Subdivision 1. General requirements; fees. (a) On payment of a fee of \$10 for each
1.9 set of two plates, or for a single plate in the case of a motorcycle plate, payment of the
1.10 registration tax required by law, and compliance with other applicable laws relating to
1.11 vehicle registration and licensing, as applicable, the commissioner shall issue:

1.12 (4) special veteran's plates to an applicant who:

1.13 (1) served in the active military service in a branch of the armed forces of the United
1.14 States or of a nation or society allied with the United States in conducting a foreign war;

1.15 (2) was discharged under honorable conditions; or meets the eligibility requirements
1.16 specified in this section;

1.17 (3) meets the requirements for the specific special plate design; and

1.18 (4) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, recreational motor vehicle, or one-ton
1.19 pickup truck, but which is not a commercial motor vehicle as defined in section 169.011,
1.20 subdivision 16; or.

2.1 ~~(2) a veteran's special motorcycle plate as described in subdivision 2, paragraph (a), (e),~~
 2.2 ~~(f), (h), (i), (j), or (m), or another special plate designed by the commissioner to an applicant~~
 2.3 ~~who is a registered owner of a motorcycle and meets the criteria listed in this paragraph and~~
 2.4 ~~in subdivision 2, paragraph (a), (e), (f), (h), (i), (j), or (m).~~

2.5 (b) The commissioner shall issue special veteran's motorcycle plates to an applicant who
 2.6 is a registered owner of a motorcycle and otherwise meets the requirements of paragraph
 2.7 (a), except that for motorcycles the commissioner may determine availability for the special
 2.8 plate designs specified in subdivisions 2c, 2d, 2e, 2h, 2j, and 2k. Special motorcycle plates
 2.9 issued under this clause section must be the same size as regular motorcycle plates. Special
 2.10 motorcycle license plates issued under this clause and are not subject to section 168.1293.

2.11 ~~(b)~~ (c) The additional fee of \$10 is payable for each set of veteran's plates, is payable
 2.12 only when the plates are issued, and is not payable in a year in which validation stickers
 2.13 are issued instead of plates.

2.14 ~~(e)~~ (d) The veteran must have a certified copy of the veteran's discharge papers, indicating
 2.15 character of discharge, at the time of application. If an applicant served in the active military
 2.16 service in a branch of the armed forces of a nation or society allied with the United States
 2.17 in conducting a foreign war and is unable to obtain a record of that service and discharge
 2.18 status, the commissioner of veterans affairs may certify the applicant as qualified for the
 2.19 veterans' plates provided under this section.

2.20 Subd. 2. **Design.** The commissioner of veterans affairs shall design the ~~emblem for the~~
 2.21 ~~veterans' special plates, subject to the approval of the commissioner, that satisfy the following~~
 2.22 ~~requirements:~~ and as specified in this section.

2.23 Subd. 2b. **Vietnam veteran.** (a) For a Vietnam veteran who served after July 1, 1961,
 2.24 and before July 1, 1978, in the active military service in a branch of the armed forces of the
 2.25 United States or a nation or society allied with the United States, the special plates must
 2.26 bear the inscription "VIETNAM VET."

2.27 Subd. 2c. **Pearl Harbor survivor.** (b) For a veteran stationed on the island of Oahu,
 2.28 Hawaii, or offshore, during the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, the special
 2.29 plates must bear the inscription "PEARL HARBOR SURVIVOR."

2.30 Subd. 2d. **World War II veteran.** (c) For a veteran who served during World War II,
 2.31 the plates must bear the inscription "WORLD WAR VET."

2.32 Subd. 2e. **Korean conflict veteran.** (d) For a veteran who served during the Korean
 2.33 Conflict, the special plates must bear the inscription "KOREAN VET."

3.1 Subd. 2f. Purple Heart. ~~(e)~~ (a) For a combat wounded veteran who is a recipient of the
3.2 Purple Heart medal, the plates must bear the inscription "COMBAT WOUNDED VET"
3.3 and have a facsimile or an emblem of the official Purple Heart medal.

3.4 (b) A member of the United States armed forces who is serving actively in the military
3.5 and who is a recipient of the Purple Heart medal is also eligible for ~~this license plate~~ the
3.6 special plates under this subdivision. The commissioner of public safety shall ensure that
3.7 information regarding the required proof of eligibility for any applicant under this paragraph
3.8 who has not yet been issued military discharge papers is distributed to the public officials
3.9 responsible for administering this section.

3.10 Subd. 2g. Persian Gulf War veteran. ~~(f)~~ For a Persian Gulf War veteran, the plates
3.11 must bear the inscription "GULF WAR VET." For the purposes of this ~~section~~ subdivision,
3.12 "Persian Gulf War veteran" means a person who served on active duty after August 1, 1990,
3.13 in a branch of the armed forces of the United States or a nation or society allied with the
3.14 United States or the United Nations during Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm,
3.15 or other military operation in the Persian Gulf area combat zone as designated in United
3.16 States Presidential Executive Order No. 12744, dated January 21, 1991.

3.17 Subd. 2h. Laos War veteran. ~~(g)~~ For a veteran who served in the Laos War after July
3.18 1, 1961, and before July 1, 1978, the special plates must bear the inscription "LAOS WAR
3.19 VET."

3.20 Subd. 2i. Campaign and service medals. ~~(h)~~ (a) For a veteran who is the recipient of:

3.21 (1) the Iraq Campaign Medal, the special plates must be inscribed with a facsimile of
3.22 that medal and must bear the inscription "IRAQ WAR VET" directly below the special
3.23 plate number;

3.24 (2) the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the special plates must be inscribed with a facsimile
3.25 of that medal and must bear the inscription "AFGHAN WAR VET" directly below the
3.26 special plate number;

3.27 (3) the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, the special plates must be
3.28 inscribed with a facsimile of that medal and must bear the inscription "GWOT VETERAN"
3.29 directly below the special plate number; or

3.30 (4) the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the special plates must bear an appropriate
3.31 inscription that includes a facsimile of that medal.

3.32 ~~(i)~~ (b) For a veteran who is the recipient of the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal,
3.33 the special plates must be inscribed with a facsimile of that medal and must bear the

4.1 inscription "GWOT VETERAN" directly below the special plate number. In addition, any
 4.2 member of the National Guard or other military reserves who has been ordered to federally
 4.3 funded state active service under United States Code, title 32, as defined in section 190.05,
 4.4 subdivision 5b, and who is the recipient of the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, is
 4.5 eligible for the ~~license~~ special plate described in this paragraph, irrespective of whether that
 4.6 person qualifies as a veteran under section 197.447.

4.7 ~~(j)~~ (c) For a veteran who is the recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal, the special
 4.8 plates must be inscribed with a facsimile of that medal and must bear the inscription
 4.9 "KOREAN DEFENSE SERVICE" directly below the special plate number.

4.10 Subd. 2j. **Bronze Star.** ~~(k)~~ For a veteran who is a recipient of the Bronze Star medal,
 4.11 the plates must bear the inscription "BRONZE STAR VET" and have a facsimile or an
 4.12 emblem of the official Bronze Star medal.

4.13 Subd. 2k. **Silver Star.** ~~(l)~~ For a veteran who is a recipient of the Silver Star medal, the
 4.14 plates must bear the inscription "SILVER STAR VET" and have a facsimile or an emblem
 4.15 of the official Silver Star medal.

4.16 Subd. 2l. **Distinguished Flying Cross.** For a veteran who is a recipient of the
 4.17 Distinguished Flying Cross medal, the special plates must bear the inscription
 4.18 "DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS VET" and have a facsimile or an emblem of the
 4.19 official Distinguished Flying Cross medal.

4.20 Subd. 2m. **Woman veteran.** ~~(m)~~ For a woman veteran, the plates must bear the inscription
 4.21 "WOMAN VETERAN" and have a facsimile or an emblem as designated by the
 4.22 commissioners of veterans affairs and public safety.

4.23 Subd. 4. **Plates transfer.** ~~(a)~~ On application to the commissioner and payment of a
 4.24 transfer fee of \$5, plates issued under subdivision 1, ~~paragraph (a), clause (1),~~ may be
 4.25 transferred to another ~~passenger automobile or recreational motor vehicle, or one-ton truck~~
 4.26 ~~described in subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clause (1),~~ if the subsequent vehicle is:

4.27 (1) qualified under subdivision 1 to bear the special plates; and

4.28 (2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued.

4.29 ~~(b) On payment of a fee of \$5, a plate issued under subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clause~~
 4.30 ~~(2), may be transferred to another motorcycle registered to the individual to whom the plate~~
 4.31 ~~was issued.~~

4.32 Subd. 6. **Rules.** The commissioner may adopt rules under the Administrative Procedure
 4.33 Act to govern the issuance and use of the special plates authorized by this section.

5.1 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2019, except that subdivision
5.2 21 applies for plate applications and issuances beginning January 1, 2021.

5.4 Subd. 5. **Applicability.** This section does not apply to a special motorcycle plate designed
5.5 by the commissioner under section 168.123, subdivision 1, ~~clause (2).~~

5.6 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2019.
