Section 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED. 1.5 An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment 1.6 is adopted, a section shall be added to article I, to read: 1.7 Sec. 18. The liberty of a parent to direct the education of their child is fundamental and 18 includes the right to choose, as an alternative to public education, a private, religious, or 1.9 home school, and the right to make reasonable choices within a public school for their child. 1.10 The state must not infringe these rights. 1.11 Sec. 2.
