## 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 123B.63, subdivision 1, is amended to read: 1.6 Subdivision 1. Creation of capital project referendum account. A district may 1.7 create a capital project referendum account as a separate account in its general fund or its 1.8 building construction fund. All proceeds from the capital project levy revenue must be 1.9 deposited in the capital project referendum account in its general fund. The portion of the 1.10 proceeds to be used for building construction must be transferred to the capital project 1.11 referendum account in its building construction fund. Interest income attributable to the 1.12 capital project referendum account must be credited to the account. 1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue in fiscal year 2017 and 1.14 1.15 later.
- Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 123B.63, subdivision 3, is amended to read: 1.16 Subd. 3. Capital project levy referendum. (a) A district may levy the local tax rate 1.17 The revenue authorized under section 126C.10, subdivision 13, may be increased in the 1.18 amount approved by a majority of the electors voting on the question to provide funds 1.19 for an approved project. The election must take place no more than five years before the 1.20 estimated date of commencement of the project. The referendum must be held on a date 1.21 set by the board. A district must meet the requirements of section 123B.71 for projects 1.22 funded under this section. If a review and comment is required under section 123B.71, 1.23
