- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 163.07, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 2. **Qualifications, salary, and term.** The county highway engineer shall be a
- 1.8 registered highway or civil engineer, registered under the laws of the state of Minnesota.
- 1.9 The county board may appoint a new county engineer for a term of only one year. All
- 1.10 reappointments shall be for a term of four years, and shall be made in May of the year in
- 1.11 which the term expires. ~~The county highway engineer shall be a citizen and resident of this~~
- 1.12 ~~state.~~ The county highway engineer's salary shall be fixed by the county board and shall be
- 1.13 payable the same as other county officers are paid. The salary shall not be reduced during
- 1.14 the county highway engineer's term of office.
