1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 126C.10, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. Basic skills revenue. A school district's basic skills revenue equals the
1.7 sum of:

1.8 (1) compensatory revenue under subdivision 3; plus

1.9 (2) the annual amount distributed to each district under Laws 2013, chapter 116,
1.10 article 1, section 58, subdivision 9;

1.11 (3) English learner revenue under section 124D.65, subdivision 5; plus and

1.12 (3) (4) \$250 times the English learner pupil units under section 126C.05, subdivision
1.13 17.

1.14 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2016
1.15 and later.
