1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; appropriating money for grants to nonprofit providers
1.3 of community-based mental health services.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH**
1.6 **SERVICES.**

1.7 (a) \$300,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2016 from the general fund to the
1.8 commissioner of human services to provide grants to three nonprofit providers of
1.9 community-based mental health services. Of this appropriation:

1.10 (1) the commissioner shall provide a \$100,000 grant to Southside Family Nurturing
1.11 Center to provide services to families whose children are at risk of abuse;

1.12 (2) the commissioner shall provide a \$100,000 grant to Teens Alone to provide
1.13 mental health services to teens and young adults who are homeless or without adult care
1.14 or family resources; and

1.15 (3) the commissioner shall provide a \$100,000 grant to the Walk-In Counseling
1.16 Center to provide free counseling services to adults and youth.

1.17 (b) This is a onetime appropriation.
