1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; REACH OUT AND READ MINNESOTA PROGRAM.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Department of Education. The sums indicated in this section are
1.7	appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of education in the fiscal years
1.8	designated.
1.9	Subd. 2. Reach Out and Read Minnesota. (a) For a grant to support Reach Out and
1.10	Read Minnesota to establish a statewide plan that encourages early childhood development
1.11	through a network of health care clinics:

1.14	(b) The grant recipient must develop and implement a plan that includes:
