1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to human services; modifying background study provisions for minors;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 245C.33, by adding a subdivision.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 245C.33, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. Background study requirements for minors. A background study completed  
1.8 under this section on a subject who is 17 years of age or younger shall be limited to the  
1.9 information required under section 245C.05, subdivision 1, unless:

1.10 (1) the commissioner has reasonable cause as defined in 245C.02, subdivision 15, to  
1.11 request other information from the subject; or

1.12 (2) the commissioner has reasonable cause to require a national criminal history record  
1.13 check as defined in section 245C.02, subdivision 15a, to require the minor to submit  
1.14 fingerprints and a photograph.
