1.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.7	Section 1. [126C.127] GENERAL EDUCATION DISPARITY AID.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Eligible districts. A school district, not including a charter school,
1.9	qualifies for general education disparity aid if: (1) the district's adjusted net tax capacity per
1.10	adjusted pupil unit is less than the value of the district at or immediately below the 20th
1.11	percentile of districts; or (2) the district's referendum market value per resident pupil unit
1.12	is less than the value of the district at or immediately below the 20th percentile of districts.
1.13	Subd. 2. General education disparity aid. (a) A district's general education disparity
1.14	aid allowance equals 0.7 times the greater of:
1.15	<u>(1) zero; or</u>
1.16	(2) the difference between (i) the amount of general education revenue per adjusted
1.17	pupil unit under section 126C.10, not including referendum revenue, for the district at or
1.18	immediately below the 20th percentile of districts, and (ii) the amount of general education
1.19	revenue per adjusted pupil unit under section 126C.10, not including referendum revenue,
1.20	for the district.
1.21	(b) For fiscal year 2018 and later, a district's general education disparity aid equals its
1.22	general education disparity aid allowance times the adjusted pupil units.
1.23	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for revenue in fiscal year 2018 and later.
