1.7	The Minnesota Lottery shall establish a scratch-off game whose receipts are
1.8	dedicated to programs for the developmentally disabled. The game shall be in play at least
1.9	once each year, on a theme and with content chosen by the lottery.

1.11	Sec. 2. SPECIAL FUND.
1.12	A fund is created within the general fund for lottery-funded programs for the
