2.1 state agencies must cooperate with the commissioner to open new, additional hunting lands  
2.2 to replace lost hunting acreage.

2.3 Subd. 4. **Reports.** (a) Beginning October 1, 2018, the commissioner must submit a  
2.4 report, by October 1 each year, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house of  
2.5 representatives and senate committees and divisions having jurisdiction over environment  
2.6 and natural resources policy and finance describing:

2.7 (1) the acreage managed by the commissioner that was sold or closed to hunting during  
2.8 the previous fiscal year and the reasons for the sales or closures; and

2.9 (2) the acreage managed by the commissioner that was opened to hunting to compensate  
2.10 for sales and closures of existing land pursuant to subdivision 3.

2.11 (b) Beginning October 1, 2018, a state agency that owns or manages lands that are  
2.12 available for hunting opportunities must submit a written report, by October 1 each year,  
2.13 to the commissioner and to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house of  
2.14 representatives and senate committees and divisions having jurisdiction over environment  
2.15 and natural resources policy and finance that includes:

2.16 (1) a list of properties that were open for hunting during the previous fiscal year;

2.17 (2) a list of properties that were sold or closed to hunting during the previous fiscal year  
2.18 and the reasons for the sales or closures; and

2.19 (3) the acreage for each property and the county where each property is located, except  
2.20 for a right-of-way or a parcel under 50 acres.
