1.9	contrary, public television stations that employ formally trained, full-time engineers or
1.10	electronic technicians whose primary function is to install, maintain, and repair broadcast
1.11	equipment are exempt from the requirements of this section.
1.12	(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, formally trained, full-time
1.13	engineers or electronic technicians whose primary function is to install, maintain, and repair
1.14	broadcast equipment, and who are employees of a public television station, are exempt
1.15	from the licensing requirements under this section and may install low-voltage wiring for
1.16	the employer. All installations and low-voltage system modifications performed pursuant
