1.6	Section 1. HEALTH SCIENCES EDUCATION FACILITY, UNIVERSITY OF
1.7	MINNESOTA; TWIN CITIES CAMPUS.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$69,333,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to demolish obsolete health
1.10	sciences facilities and to design, renovate, furnish, equip, and construct a health sciences
1.11	education facility on the Twin Cities campus to meet the needs of the Medical School and
