BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. NATURAL RESOURCES; MINNESOTA BIOMES.

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

fund to the commissioner of natural resources to design and construct outdoor classroom
- 1.9

space and landscapes representing Minnesota biomes at the new James Ford Bell Museum
- 1.10

of Natural History on the St. Paul campus of the University of Minnesota.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
- 1.13

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$4,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
