1.9	include any member of the class of fluorinated organic chemicals containing at least one

1.11	(2) "ski wax" means a lubricant applied to the bottom of snow runners, including skis
1.12	and snowboards, to improve their grip and glide properties.
1.13	Subd. 2. Prohibition. (a) A person must not manufacture, distribute, sell, or offer for
1.14	sale in the state ski wax or a related tuning product that contains perfluoroalkyl and
