1.5	Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND BORDERING PUBLIC

1.7	(a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45; 282.01, subdivision 1a; and
1.8	282.018, subdivision 1, and the public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282,
1.9	Dakota County may convey to the city of Rosemount for no consideration the tax-forfeited
1.10	land bordering public water that is described in paragraph (c).
1.11	(b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The
1.12	attorney general may make necessary changes to the legal description to correct errors and
1.13	ensure accuracy. The conveyance must provide that the land reverts to the state if the city
1.14	of Rosemount stops using the land for park or trail purposes.
