1.7	(a) All child care centers licensed under this chapter and Minnesota Rules, chapter
1.8	9503, must have a director who is knowledgeable about and understands the implications
1.9	of Minnesota Rules, parts 9503.0005 to 9503.0170, and applicable laws in this chapter,
1.10	chapter 245C, and section 626.556. The director's responsibilities shall include, but are
1.11	not limited to:
1.12	(1) monitoring the implementation of the program's policies and procedures;
1.13	(2) monitoring program compliance with applicable licensing laws and rules;
1.14	(3) supervising staff persons;
1.15	(4) providing oversight of staff person training; and
