- (b) The superintendent may operate a fusion center. By cooperating with state and local government entities, federal agencies, fusion centers in other states, and the part of the private sector that provides critical infrastructure as that term is defined in United States Code, title 42, section 5195C(e), the fusion center will assist in the detection, prevention, and investigation of, and response to, criminal and terrorist activities.
