1.6	This chapter may be cited as the "Minnesota Public Benefit Corporation Act."
1.7	Sec. 2. [304A.02] DEFINITIONS.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Applicability. For purposes of this chapter, the terms defined in this

1.10	Subd. 2. Best interests of the corporation. "Best interests of the corporation"
1.11	means those goals and objectives that are reasonably believed to provide for long-term
1.12	public benefit or to advance one or more interests of stakeholders.
