1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$ is appropriated from the bond proceeds account
1.9	in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation to construct an additional
1.10	lane in each direction on marked U.S. Highway 169 in the city of Calumet, to improve
1.11	roadway safety near the new fire hall.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond

1.14	shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$ in the manner, upon the
