- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 609.475, is amended to read:
- 1.6 **609.475 IMPERSONATING POLICE OFFICER; MILITARY.**
- 1.7 Whoever falsely impersonates a police ~~or military~~ officer, active or reserve
- 1.8 component military service member, veteran, or public official with intent to mislead
- 1.9 another into believing that the impersonator is actually such officer, service member,
- 1.10 veteran, or official is guilty of a misdemeanor.
