1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. MARKED TRUNK HIGHWAY 23; APPROPRIATION.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$ is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of transportation to construct marked Trunk Highway 23 as a four-lane divided
1.8	highway (1) from the point where marked Trunk Highway 23 ceases as a four-lane divided
1.9	highway near the intersection with Kandiyohi County State-Aid Highway 31, located east
1.10	of New London, to the point where marked Trunk Highway 23 commences as a four-lane
1.11	divided highway, located southwest of Paynesville, and (2) from the point where marked
1.12	Trunk Highway 23 ceases as a four-lane divided highway, located northeast of Paynesville,
1.13	to the point where marked Trunk Highway 23 commences as a four-lane divided highway,
