1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 151.21, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 11. Requirement to dispense ivermectin prescriptions. No pharmacist or
1.9 pharmacist intern may refuse to dispense an ivermectin prescription ordered by a physician
1.10 or other licensed practitioner.

1.11 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 151.37, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.12 read:

1.13 Subd. 17. No prohibition on prescribing ivermectin. No physician or other licensed
1.14 practitioner may be prohibited from prescribing ivermectin.
