1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9	to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Lakefield to predesign, design,
1.10	construct, and equip the replacement of publicly owned infrastructure and facilities. This
1.11	appropriation includes money for a new municipal water treatment facility and distribution
1.12	system to provide clean drinking water to residents; new wastewater treatment ponds and
1.13	collection system as well as improvements to the existing wastewater treatment facility;
