BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **EAST SIDE FREEDOM LIBRARY.**

1.6

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$2,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.7

fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the

1.8

city of St. Paul to complete the design and to renovate, restore, construct, furnish, and

1.9

equip capital improvements to the Carnegie Library formerly known as the Arlington

1.10

Hills Public Library. Nonstate contributions to improvements at the library made before

1.11

or after the enactment of this subdivision are considered to be a sufficient match, and no

1.12

further nonstate match is required.

1.13

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

1.14

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue

1.15

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$2,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

1.16

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

1.17

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
