1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; insurance; prohibiting health plans from limiting testing for
1.3 opioids; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62Q.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 62Q.472] SCREENING AND TESTING FOR OPIOIDS.

1.6 A health plan is prohibited from limiting coverage for screenings and urinalysis testing
1.7 for opioids. Prohibited coverage limits include but are not limited to limiting the frequency
1.8 or number of screenings or tests.

1.9 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2021, and applies to health
1.10 plans offered, issued, or renewed on or after that date.
