1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; expanding use of motorized vehicles on wildlife
1.3 management areas by hunters with physical disabilities; amending Minnesota
1.4 Statutes 2018, section 97A.137, subdivision 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97A.137, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. Use of motorized vehicles by disabled hunters with physical disability. The
1.8 commissioner may issue a special permit, without a fee, authorizing a hunter A person with
1.9 a permanent physical disability to may use a snowmobile, highway-licensed vehicle,
1.10 all-terrain vehicle, or motor boat in wildlife management areas. To qualify for a permit
1.11 under this subdivision, The disabled person with a physical disability must possess:

- 1.12 (1) the required hunting licenses; and
1.13 (2) a permit to shoot from a stationary vehicle under section 97B.055, subdivision 3 a
1.14 valid disability parking certificate authorized by section 169.345 or valid license plates
1.15 issued under section 168.021.
