LOUIS COUNTY HERITAGE AND ARTS CENTER. 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.7 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to St. Louis 1.8 County for asset preservation of the St. Louis County Heritage and Arts Center, also known 1.9 as the Depot, in Duluth. The asset preservation work includes predesign, design, construction, 1.10 and renovation work for replacement of or improvements to mechanical, electrical, heating, 1.11 ventilating, and air conditioning systems; life-safety elements of the building; and exterior 1.12 building envelope integrity.
