The commissioner shall ensure that grants are distributed to rural and urban counties. The commissioner shall require grantees to use all available third-party reimbursement sources as a condition of receipt of grant funds. The commissioner must consult with school districts that have not received school-linked mental health grants but want to collaborate with a community mental health provider.
