1.1 A bill for an act

relating to economic development; requiring the commissioner of employment and economic development to enter into a contract for certain information technology projects; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 1.5 116J.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [116J.0126] CONTRACT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS.

The commissioner of employment and economic development must enter into a contract with one or more vendors for the development and completion of an information and telecommunications technology project if the total expected cost is more than \$1,000,000. The contract must be solicited, awarded, and executed according to the requirements of chapter 16C. Notwithstanding section 16C.08, subdivision 2, a competitive proposal process must be used for professional and technical services related to a project subject to this section, regardless of whether a current state agency employee is able and available to perform the services called for by the contract. The state chief information officer may submit a proposal in response to a solicitation required by this section.
