The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Capital Investment Division

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the North Shore Trail in
- 1.3 Forest Lake; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **FOREST LAKE; NORTH SHORE TRAIL.**
- 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$2,250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.7 to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Forest Lake to design, engineer,
- 1.8 and reconstruct approximately 2.5 miles of the North Shore Trail in the city to add a
- 1.9 pedestrian trail from Greenway Avenue to Kulencamp Park at 230th Street. This
- 1.10 appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and budget determines
- 1.11 that at least \$2,000,000 has been committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
- 1.12 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.14 the state in an amount up to \$2,250,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
