BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 245A.14, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.7

to read:

Subd. 16. **Household pets; family child care.** A reptile commonly kept as a household
- 1.9

pet that is maintained in good health, is not poisonous or otherwise potentially dangerous,
- 1.10

and meets all other applicable requirements under state and local laws, rules, and ordinances
- 1.11

shall be permitted as a pet housed within the residence of a family day care program, provided
- 1.12

that the children attending the day care program do not handle the reptile.
- 1.13

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
