1.7	made must not proceed until the recipient undertaking the project has notified the chairs
1.8	and ranking minority members of the senate Capital Investment and Finance Committees
1.9	and the house of representatives Capital Investment and Ways and Means Committees that
1.10	the work is ready to begin. Notice is not required for:
1.11	(1) capital projects needed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act, for:
1.12	(2) asset preservation projects to which section 16B.307 applies, or for:
1.13	(3) projects funded by an agency's operating budget; or
1.14	(4) projects funded by a capital asset preservation and replacement account under section
1.15	16A.632, or a higher education asset preservation and replacement account under section
